# **Food Waste Trial**

Question: How are HDC weighing up the environmental costs of caddies

- Providing one plastic tub reducing food waste and reducing food waste being added to landfill for a long period of time. Helps with behaviour change, with cross over into other areas. And at end of life, they can be recycled.

# Food waste survey

650 responses. Negative feedback on social media. A lot of data, which we are going through, and then creating some infographics on different themes that have come out of it. These can be shared among the group for feedback before posting out.

#### **Nappies**

We have a nappy discount incentive. On top of this we also have invested in 10 basic kits for loaning to those that would still struggle to invest in a kit. If anyone has any contacts, or know anyone that could make use of them.
