## **Food Waste Trial**

Refuse tonnages have reduced by 22 tonnes (across 12 weeks) in the same period of the previous year

This equates to 2kg per household per week save from being landfill

Garden = 1 tonne less, however feedback from residents suggests that many are reducing their food waste

Survey just completed. – 146 responses – 15% of those who had caddies.

93 weren't previous composting their food waste

20 are still putting into grey bin and some of these are split between both garden and grey bin.

Hopeful that the trial can be extended

Common reason for not doing it as it is 'dirty', 'smelly'.

Need to promote the positives
