Food Waste Trial

Report was finalised today but not signed off. Waste Min staff are recommending to roll out a further 1,000 in each quarter going forward. Suggested for Yaxley, who have

4,000 residents and we have good relationship with parish council to help support. Additional budget required for the liners? Supply a set amount at first (2-3 a week) and then to be supplied at cost going forward to users. 300,000 bags for 6 months for the 4,000 properties in Yaxley. In surveys, liners were considered to make a difference and were favourable to encourage more followers and to keep them proactive. From surveys taken, behaviours in multiple ways were noted to food waste trials (reducing plastic / looking at all waste created).

Litter Minimisation

Hunts Litter Wobbles has been created on Facebook but not shared widely yet. Share litter picks/ideas etc beginning to grow.

Agreed to join Waste Minimisation and Litter Minimisations in Hunts Waste Busters. Good idea and no objections. Danette to share and widen.

Sustainable Business Community Pledge

Looking to make some changes. Audits being finalised for current members, but going forward, looking to make changes. Not many members – about 14 on the list – been going a year. Looking to expand the audit to include other sustainable measures; transport, energy etc.

Waste Min staff will be doing a Press Release in the next month or so – a relaunch as only in Huntingdon so far. Looking at next meeting for more information.

Tom suggested having a form of guidance. Also take to business fairs and seeing if any grants available to assist. Tom happy to assist with this project.

Any Other Business

Danette – food waste hubs – ticking on in the background. Danette to keep plugging away. If anybody has any contacts, please share.

Lara asked now that there are 3 team members – how will they be organised. Terri is the new team member, who has replaced Mina. This is an existing role and so roles will not be changing very much, but now she has settled in more it should enable Heidi a bit more time back to return to more strategic projects.
