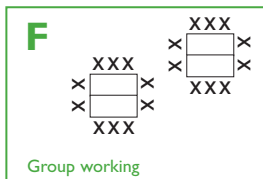
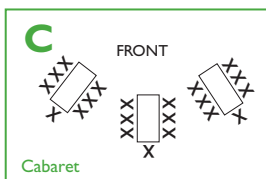
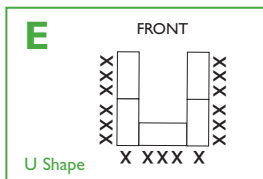
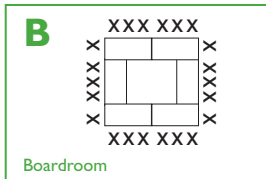
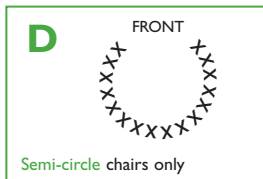
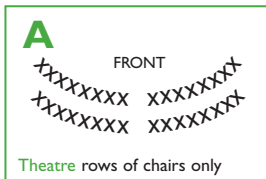
Refreshments

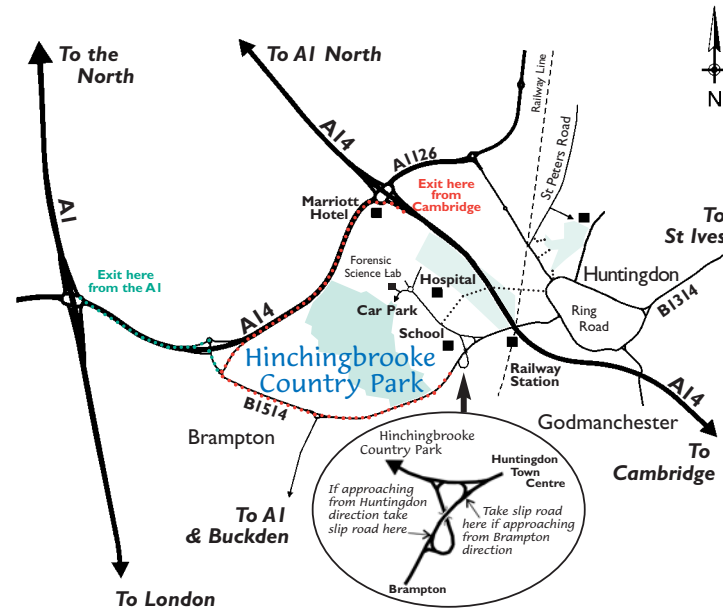
PLAN OF THE COUNTRYSIDE CENTRE
