Huntingdon West Area Action Plan Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulations 24(2) and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008, notice is hereby given that Huntingdonshire District Council adopted the Huntingdon West Area Action Plan as a Development Plan Document on 23 February 2011.

The Area Action Plan forms part of the Huntingdonshire Local Development Framework (LDF) and will replace relevant parts of the existing Huntingdonshire Local Plan 1995 and the Huntingdonshire Local Plan Alteration 2002. The Huntingdon West Area Action Plan is the second document to be adopted, following the Core Strategy adopted in September 2009.

Any such application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting when the plan was adopted.
