### **Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 The Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008**

#### **Core Strategy Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulations 24(2) and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008, notice is hereby given that Huntingdonshire District Council adopted the Core Strategy as a Development Plan Document on 23 September 2009. The Core Strategy will set out the vision, objectives, spatial development strategy and overarching policies that will guide development in Huntingdonshire to 2026.

The Core Strategy will form part of the Huntingdonshire Local Development Framework (LDF) and will replace relevant parts of the existing Huntingdonshire Local Plan 1995 and the Huntingdonshire Local Plan Alteration 2002. The LDF comprises a number of DPDs and AAPs that set out policies and proposals for the development and use of land in the District. The Core Strategy is the first of these to be adopted.
