

Pre-Application Advice – Environmental Information Regulations

Requests may be received in respect of Environmental Information Regulations legislation to disclose information.

The background as to why this might happen is contained in a report considered and approved by this Authority's Development Control Panel on 24 April 2006, a copy of which can be obtained from <u>our website</u>.

Although there are various exceptions within the legislation that might prevent disclosure of an enquiry, all these have to be seen against the 'public interest' test. This means that in every case, an Authority may refuse to disclose information *only* if in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exception outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
