Statement of Adoption of the Cambridgeshire Flood and Water Supplementary Planning Document

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, that Huntingdonshire District Council adopted the Huntingdonshire Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) under the provisions of section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on 20 April 2017.

The SPD has been prepared to provide further guidance on flood risk and water management matters to support the policies in the development plan. It will assist developers, householders and landowners in preparing planning applications for submission to the Council and will also help the Council in determining relevant planning applications.

A draft SPD was subject to public consultation between 4 September and 16 October 2015. The main issues raised in representations during consultation and how these have been addressed in the adopted SPD are set out in the Consultation Statement.
