Dear Annette,

I understand that the process is coming to a conclusion and that Alconbury is not on the agenda at the moment, but a couple of points of interest have come to light that I feel the Inspector may wish to ask HDC.

1. It appears from a report of a meeting of the Alconbury Brook Partnership, relayed to the Parish Council by our liaison; that the County council flood officers involved with the Alconbury scheme were apparently not aware nor had seemingly been consulted about the plan for housing.

Alconbury is apparently a special case due to its being prone to flash flooding. This makes it a unique environment.

- 2. There are proposals with Luminus housing group to convert the Crown Gardens retirement housing into accommodation for up to 20 families to get them out of B&Bs. This would have a commensurate affect on the school etc.
- 3. We have responded to the HDC request to confirm the pdf of the 46A community bus timetable. It is as we declared at the meeting. It should also be noted that there is limited disabled access for he elderly with this service.

Apologies for the late nature of this interjection, but some of this information only surfaced today.

Alconbury is serviced by a community mini bus service with 4 inbound services from Huntingdon and four out bound to Huntingdon (as per the attached timetable).
