Is the proposal within 250m of a pond?		
Does the proposed development constitute or include the modification, conversion, demolition or removal of any part of a building/structure (especially roof voids) involving the following?  • All agricultural buildings (e.g. farmhouses/barns) particularly of brick or stone and/or exposed wooden beams?  • All buildings with weather boarding/hanging tiles that are within 200m of woodland and/or water?  • Pre-1960 detached buildings/structures within 200m of woodland/water?  • Pre-1914 buildings within 400m or woodland/water?  • Pre-1914 buildings with gable ends or slate roofs, regarding of location?  • All tunnels, kilns, icehouses, adits, military fortifications, air raid shelters, cellars and similar underground structures?  • Proposals affecting gravel pits or quarries, crevices or caves?  • All bridge structures, aqueducts and viaducts?  • Lighting of churches and Listed Buildings or flood lighting of green space within 50mif woodland, water, field hedgerows or lines of trees with connectivity to woodland or water?  • Affecting woodland, or field hedgerows. Especially those near to water bodies?  • Proposals within 200m of rivers, streams, canals, lakes or other aquatic habitats?  • Buildings and walls with thick, dense ivy covering?  • Tall walls (2m+) with crevices?  • Proposed tree work (felling/lopping) old/veteran trees  Does the proposed development directly affect any derelict land, allotments, woodland or hedgerows/ditches?  Will the proposed development impact directly/indirectly a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) or County Wildlife Site (CWS), SPAs, SACs ,NNRs, RAMSAR sites or Local Geological Sites (LGS)?
