

# What do residents think of Huntingdonshire District Council Services?





- From Monday 8 November to Wednesday 30 November, the council undertook a residents' survey which asked people to share their views on some of the council's services.
- There were **855 responses to the survey.** It was promoted on the council's website and social media accounts. It was also shared with HDC councillors and with Town and Parish Councils as well as other networks associated with HDC.
- The survey was made up of 15 questions and asked people how satisfied or dissatisfied they are with the way the council runs things and whether it provides value for money.

Did you know that for every £1 of council tax collected, Huntingdonshire District Council only gets to keep 7p of it? Around 71p goes to Cambridgeshire County Council, 12p goes to the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cambridgeshire, 4p goes to Cambridgeshire Fire Authority and 6p goes to Town or Parish Councils.
