


How to Create a Portal Account

Welcome to Environmental Health and Licensing Portal

This portal provides Environmental Health and Licensing services for Cambridge City Council and Huntingdonshire District Council. In addition, it provides access to the licence register for South Cambridgeshire District Council. You do not need to register and sign in to view the licence register, but by registering and signing you can access the following online services:

Click on the red 'REGISTER HERE' button in the top right hand corner of the page.

This will take you to the Registration page.



You will receive a verification email in the next few minutes with the subject title **“Council Direct Registration Successful”**.


Very important: You will need to verify your account before you can sign it.

Sign in using your newly created account details.

Once you have signed in, you will be directed to the portal page.

Select ‘Huntingdonshire District Council’ from the ‘Select your Local Council Area’ dropdown, then click on ‘Licensing’.



A menu should open on the left-hand side or scroll across to see this.

Select your required application from the menu.
