STATEMENT OF REASONS

Cambridgeshire County Council has made an application to the Department for Transport under the Traffic Management Act 2004 (2004 Act), for the District of Huntingdonshire to be designated as “a civil enforcement area and a special enforcement area”.

The designation and the proposed order will enable the Huntingdonshire District Council and its authorised officers to utilise Civil Enforcement Powers to enforce off street parking within the District of Huntingdonshire. Civil Enforcement Officers will issue Penalty Charge Notices in respect of contraventions.

This Civil Parking Enforcement, (Off Street Parking Places) Order, will:

- A. Introduce civil enforcement under the 2004 Act to the District of Huntingdonshire off-street parking places where regulated.
- B. achieve continuity and equal standards of enforcement across the District of Huntingdonshire, improving car park regulation.
- C. Enable all prohibitions and restrictions within the District of Huntingdonshire off-street parking places, to be made into a new map-based Order.

It appears to the District Council as the Order making Authority, that it is necessary to make this Order in the interests of providing consistent and proper controls to the car parks and to be able to enforce the areas as necessary.
