#### Data and Trends

- The waste min team use data on recycling bin rejections to influence communications.
- The main reasons for recycling bins being rejected are black sacks, textiles and polystyrene
- Sampling data from the recycling facility provides a monthly breakdown of materials that they are having to reject (material which crews did spot before emptying) Highest materials are food waste, black sacks and textiles
- In 2022/23, 58% of materials collected is either recycled or composted

#### **Current Key Strategies**

- Using the waste hierarchy, the team are working on encouraging waste reduction, promoting reuse and enabling recycling.

# **Ongoing Project**

#### Waste reduction and Litter Minimisation

- Fight Food Waste we'll be asking resident to pledge to reduce their food waste. This will be a countywide project starting in July
- Street Food Box we met with a local company who have established a reusable takeaway box which could be used by on-street outlets and at events. This is just a possible solution which event organisers could explore themselves
- St Ives Against Rubbish Initiative letters for retail and hospitality businesses in St Ives are almost confirmed. Posters have been designed and will be printed soon. Cigarette Voting bins have been purchased and will be sited in two locations within the town. We'll monitor the impacts in St Ives extend to our other town centres
- Al cameras have been installed in a couple of location where littering is at its highest. We'll have more information on these at the next meeting.

## Reuse

- Met with the organisers of the toy library in Brampton to see how waste min can support the initiative
- Promotion of reuse via our socials clothing shops/vinted and refill shops
- As part a countywide scheme we have passed on 50 wet wipe packs to new parents. We're asking for their feedback (good or bad)
- We have discounts available for reusable nappies and will continue to promote the scheme
- We recently met with Ikigia, St Ives and similar with the toy library and other initiatives will look at how waste min can support

## Recycle

- We're looking at how we can work with residents who have communal collections to help to reduce contamination and improve recycling. We've met with Cogniss who have developed a behavioural change App which is being used with Veolia customers. More on this at a later date
