NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

Notice is hereby given that Huntingdonshire District Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers regulating the use of its car parks under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers proposes to make the above-named Order, the effect of which will be as follows:

- A. Introduce civil enforcement under the 2004 Act to the District of Huntingdonshire offstreet parking places where regulated.
- B. Enable all prohibitions and restrictions within the District of Huntingdonshire off-street parking places, to be made into a map-based Order.

Full details of this proposal are set out in the draft Order which, together with the attached plans, and a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, can be viewed on-line on the council's website.

Persons wishing to respond to this consultation should do so preferably using the online feedback form.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order may do so either by submitting responses by email to <u>parkingconsultation@huntingdonshire.gov.uk</u> or by sending a written statement of objection, stating the grounds on which the objection is made to the Head of Economy, Regeneration & Housing before the 29th May 2025.
